Registration Information

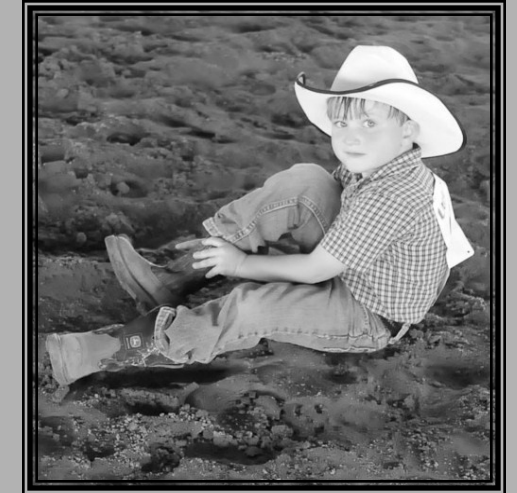
Events **may fill** prior to the rodeo.

Pre-register to avoid event fill-ups.

Pre-registration ends on October 22, 2011

- Pre-registration must be **mailed** in with a check or money order. No will be held registration without proper forms and money. Do not send cash in the mail.
- No refunds will be made under any circumstances.**
- If it rains rodeo day, we will run the rodeo in the rain. Lightning will cause a delay, and the rodeo will resume as soon as it is safe to do so. COWBOY UP!
- Gate fee: \$5 per person.
- Birth certificates are required on children ages 12, 13, 14, 15 and 16. You must send a copy with pre-registration. If no copy is provided with pre-registration you will be required to bring a copy of the birth certificate on rodeo day. If no copy is provided, the contestant will be disqualified and no refund will be given.**
- Registration will close at 9:00 AM on rodeo day.
- No new registration or changes will be allowed after that time. If you need to pick up pre-registration at a later time, please make a note on your registration form.
- There will be a \$30 fee for all returned checks.
- Helmets and vests will be provided by the stock contractor for rough stock events.
- Contestants must furnish their own mouth pieces, piggin' string, ropes, and gloves.

RODEO RULES

- ◆ Lead lines are allowed in the Pew Wee Division but will not count toward the All Around Award.
- ◆ Speed event: If a horse breaks a pattern and/or barrier, no second try will be given. The contestant will awarded a score of "zero" and must exit the arena immediately.
- ◆ All participants must be able to perform the requirements of the event without adult assistance. This means NO LEAD LINES IN ANY EVENT INCLUDING THE GRAND ENTRY. A parent/guardian may ride double with hi/her child in the Grand Entry .
- ◆ A parent/guardian must be on the premises of the Chambers County Ag Arena and must supervise his/her children at all times. This will be strictly enforced. No horses will be allowed in the vendor area (mounted or unmounted).
- ◆ Horses may not be left unattended unless they are securely tethered to a trailer.
- ◆ Horses, riders, and contestants may not be in the alley leading to the arena unless they have been called for an upcoming event.
- ◆ Contestants are responsible for reporting to the arena for the events they have registered. If contestants fail to report for an event, they will be called three (3) times by either the announcer or arena director. After the third call that contestant will be scratched from that event as a "no "show".
- ◆ The management of the Little Buckaroos Rodeo reserves the right to dismiss persons for any conduct that distracts from the enjoyment by others in attendance.
- ◆ Only rodeo personnel will be allowed in the arena with the participants. This includes parents and guardians. This is strictly enforced.
- ◆ A negative Coggins Test dated within one year of the rodeo must be presented at the gate for each horse.
- ◆ The rodeo will begin at 9:30 AM and the gates open at 8:00 AM. Final registration ends at 9:00 AM.
- ◆ No dogs are allowed at the rodeo or on the Chambers County Ag Arena premises on leashes or in trucks or trailers. Leave dogs at home.
- ◆ No barbeque grills or open fires are allowed on the Chambers County Ag Arena premises.
- ◆ You are welcome to stay overnight at the Chambers County Ag Arena . (Limited hook-ups are available)
- ◆ No hanging on the fence. No standing in front of the fence blocking the view of spectators sitting in the stands.
- ◆ Contestants who are entered in mutton bustin', bull riding, calf riding, and chute dog wrestling will be required to wear a stock bracelet. The bracelets will be issued at final registration.
- ◆ Contestants will not be allowed to enter the arena or compete in any event without a back number!
- ◆ If a contestant loses a number they must report to the registration table to get another number before they may participate in another event.
- ◆ Dummy roping; two (2) throws on round one; one throw with 3 ft. back-up from line
- ◆ Trail course: weave through cones (trot or lope); back through obstacle; side pass; cross bridge; log drag (time limit 2 minutes)
- ◆ Age divisions will be determined by what age the contestant was on January 1, 2011.

Points and Award
Information



- ◆ All events count toward the All-Around Cowboy/Cowgirl Award.
- ◆ Age divisions: Pee Wee 7 & under; Junior Division 8-12; Senior Division 13-16.
- ◆ Lead lines are allowed in the Pew Wee Division but will not count toward the All Around Award
- ◆ In the event of a tie for All-Around Cowboy/girl, the contestant with the highest points in the arena race will be declared the winner.
- ◆ All-Around Awards will be awarded in each division.

Points

Points will be awarded from first to fifth place in all divisions.

Ribbons

Ribbons for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place will be awarded in each event.

Claiming Ribbons

- ◆ Award ribbons will be handed out in the arena after each event
- ◆ Ribbons or awards must be claimed by the end of the following event or awards will be forfeited.

Back Numbers

Contestants will not be allowed to enter the arena or compete in any event without a back number!

If a contestant loses a number they must report to the registration table to get another number before they may participate in another event.

Stock Bracelets

Contestants who are entered in mutton bustin', bull riding, calf riding, and chute dog wrestling will be required to wear a stock bracelet. The bracelets will be issued at final registration.
